Sacrament Preparation

Baptism

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist

These sacraments are generally celebrated in the 2nd grade. Preparation includes two consecutive, completed years of faith formation and workshop participation.

Confirmation

This sacrament is generally celebrated in the 10th grade.

Two consecutive, completed years of Faith formation (8th & 9th) are required.

In addition, students must attend a weekend retreat, complete a minimum of 25 hours of service (spread across 8th-10th grades), and complete a journal workbook.
